

THE PARENT/GUARDIAN/SPECTATOR CONTRACT YEAR 2010

The Stallion Program has a history of being the best, in providing a positive Sportsmanship Environment for our players. Our program is bigger than any one player, coach or parent/guardian/spectator. We require the following: Grade_____ Jersey#_____

1. Encourage members of both teams.
2. Keep all comments positive.
3. **. Only players and coaches are allowed on the field, no exceptions**
4. Leave the coaching to the coaches. If you have suggestions or would like to coach next years team please volunteer so you can attend the mandatory coaching clinics, pass the background check and sign the coaches contract. **Do not coach any player during a game.**
5. **Criticizing the officials, coaches, opponents or fans will not be tolerated at all. Same goes for abusive language or cursing. This is youth sports, everyone makes mistakes.**
6. Be supportive, creating unnecessary drama or stirring controversy is grounds for dismissal from the program.
7. **Do not beg or suggest calls to the referees. Sportsmanship and class will be displayed and no one is to directly question the refs for any referees call.**
8. **Any parent who threatens, attacks, or shows any anger or aggression towards a ref. will be expelled from the program. Our young players will be watching your actions.**
9. You are responsible for all family members and friends attending the games to watch your child.
10. No open alcoholic beverages on the fields or parking areas at practices or games or any Stallion event.
11. Help make this a positive and fun experience for all.
12. Report any violations to head coach or Commissioners. Get involved.
13. Supply the head coach with written information of any and all medial or behavior situations of your child. Give the head coach any inhalers or EPI pens in a zip lock bag with child's name to be held for emergency's during entire season. Notify us if you are a certified or licensed medical professional.
14. It is your responsibility to make sure your child gets to every practice on time and is picked up when practice is over. If there is a reason you can't personally get there on time please car pool or make other arrangements for the benefit of the team. Practices start sharply at 6:00pm-8:15pm. Contact your head coach for any help.
15. Place your child's name on all water bottles. Use a label maker for name on back of helmet. **It is parent responsibility to recertify helmets every 3 years.**
16. Any player wanting to change to another Stallion or Outlaw team must sit out one full year.
17. All families will be scheduled and responsible to work all home games.
18. Dogs or any pets not permitted at practices, games, or any Stallion event.
19. I/WE have read the **"Parents Must Read" link on the Stallion web site.**
20. All Stallion property is **"Copy Right" and" Licensed"** including but not limited to names or anything describing the "Stallions Organization", "Lakota Stallions", "Stallions", "The Stallions", "Stallions Football" etc. and the private "Stallion Logo"

established June 21, 2010. The private “Stallion Logo” is the only logo to be used after June 21st 2010 except on helmets. Any use of any of the above, but not limited to the above, without being Licensed through the Stallions is not allowed and will be punishable by law. “Home Town Threads” located in Meijers is the only Authorized Licensed logo wear supplier. Any use of any other supplier is in violation of Stallion licensing rights.

Policy Enforcement:

1. Individuals may be given one warning for inappropriate activity.
2. Individuals that continue any inappropriate activity will be asked to leave the fields and the player will be removed from the game until the parent/guardian/spectator has left.
3. Other sanctions as deemed necessary may be enforced, including permanent ban.

Liability Release & Medical Information:

I hereby release & discharge the Lakota Stallions; its officers, coaches, sponsors & representatives from any and all obligations & for liability resulting from accidents or injuries, or otherwise occurring as a result of my child’s participation in or attendance any activity. In the event my child becomes ill or injured during any activity, its official coaches and representatives have my permission to have reasonable adequate medical services provided to my child, including transportation to appropriate emergency medial facilities.
